

CCCC Registration at Youth Training-Responsibilities for Parents/Carers and the Club

Important Message

We would like to reiterate a couple of points regarding Challow and Childrey Cricket Clubs responsibilities whilst your child is in our care.

As you may be aware, we operate a registration system where children must be "ticked into" the session and given a wristband and then "ticked out" of the session and return their wristband. Whilst there is no formal requirement for the club to have such a registration system this seems to be the most sensible way of accounting for the children in our care in accordance with ECB guidelines (Safe Hands Policy).

In order to ensure that parents understand the point at which CCCC becomes responsible for their child we would like to confirm that CCCC will assume responsibility for your child at the point they register (6.15pm - 6.30pm) and are given their wristband. Conversely, CCCC discharges its responsibility for your child at the point they are de-registered (8.00pm) and hand back their wristband.

It is important therefore that parents/carers are present to collect their children in good time for the end of the session.

With the co-operation of parents/carers, the registration system plus many other measures that are already in place will ensure that children learn to play cricket in the safest environment possible.
